



## LAKE OKEECHOBEE & ESTUARY RECOVERY

*A bold and aggressive action plan*

### DIRECTIONS:

#### From Fort Myers/Southwest Florida:

Take SR 80 to US Hwy 27 and turn left (north). Continue north on US Hwy 27 over the Caloosahatchee River and through Moore Haven. Turn right (east) onto SR 78 and continue on SR 78 east over the Kissimmee River toward Okeechobee. Just before you reach the intersection with US Hwy 441, you will turn right, going over the Herbert Hoover Dike and arriving at Okeechobee Beach.

#### From West Palm Beach/South Florida:

Take SR 710 (Beeline Highway) to the end at SR 70. Turn left (west) and travel to the intersection with Parrott Avenue (US Hwy 441) and turn left (south). Continue south on Parrott Ave until you reach the point where the Herbert Hoover Dike is directly ahead and you must turn to go around the lake. Turn right (west) onto SR 78. You will then take an immediate left over the Herbert Hoover Dike, arriving at Okeechobee Beach.

#### From Stuart/Treasure Coast:

Take SR 70 (Beeline Highway) into Okeechobee, turn left (south) on Parrott Ave and follow the directions above.

#### From Orlando/Central Florida:

Take Florida's Turnpike to the YeeHaw Junction exit at SR 60. Turn right (west) on SR 60. In less than 1 mile, you will turn left (south) on US Hwy 441. Continue traveling south on US Hwy 441 to the dike and follow the directions above.
