SCHEDULE 5.a

SURVEY REQUIREMENTS

1. The Boundary Survey, shall be in strict compliance with Florida Statutes Chapter 472, Land Surveying, Chapter 61G 17-6 of the Florida Administrative Code (Minimum Technical Standards) and the District's requirements specified herein.
2. All horizontal data shall be collected in and based on the North American Datum of 1983, 2007 adjustment (NAD 83/07) East Zone. Horizontal coordinate control shall be established from existing National Geodetic Survey (NGS) 2nd Order control or higher in the area by using a minimum of conventional NGS Third Order field observation procedures.
3. Establish State Plane Coordinates and Latitude and Longitude (NAD83), on all boundary corners and set control points. The state plane coordinate and Latitude and Longitude (NAD83) shall be shown for each corner.
4. Monument all changes in directions. All *set* corners shall be a standard 1-inch iron pipe with Aluminum cap stamped with the firms LB number driven to substantial depth to insure stability. The monument shall be witnessed with a carsonite stake *or* a steel guard post. Based on the rock depth the consultant may set the permanent mark in the rock, this method will need prior approval by the District.
5. All easements evidenced by a Record Document which have been delivered to the surveyor shall be shown, both those burdening and those benefiting the property surveyed, indicating recording information. Also, the surveyor is responsible to show any unrecorded evidence of such found in the field. Encroachments onto and off of the property shall be shown.
6. Complete Certified Corner Records for all found or set original government sectional breakdown corners, and file with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FLDEP). Corner references will not be set according to the letter from FLDEP.
7. The most recent high resolution Aerial shall be shown as a back drop for this work.
8. The Surveyor's Report shall be a part of the drawing set and shall be on the cover sheet.
9. When the contractors come to common lines the coordinate values supplied for the surveys shall be the same.



Dear Ruth:

We have established the following protocol for the District's and their consultants' review of U. S. Sugar's Trade Secret Records:

1. The review will take place in the Poinciana Room on the 5th floor of Gunster Yoakley commencing upon August 11, 2008. Please ask for Chris Murray, a litigation paralegal, who will coordinate and monitor the review.
2. Chris will ask each person for photo identification. Each person will sign a sign-in sheet. Any consultants of the District (other than District employees) will be required to sign a Confidentiality Agreement prior to access to Trade Secret Records.
3. A computer will be set up for each of the 15 people you have identified will be coming. You will have access only to the documents on the CDs (no Internet access or other access). 5. No electronic device (cell phone, blackberry, laptop, etc.) is to be used while you are reviewing the documents.

Schedule:

1. The review will take place between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. with 1 hour for lunch between 12:00 – 1:00 p.m. If you require access outside of these hours, please contact me in advance and we will use all efforts to accommodate your request. When everyone returns, the receptionist will notify Chris who will then take you back into the room. You are not to enter the room unless Chris or another Gunster representative is present.

Monitoring the review:

1. Chris will monitor the review. Chris will be relieved as needed for short periods of time by her designee who will be familiar with the protocol.

Questions and Contact Person:

1. Any questions by the District personnel should be written on a piece of paper if I am not immediately available to answer. I will be the contact person to answer questions. Chris will let me know when the District has questions or you can feel free to contact me directly.



Subject: Potential purchase of 187,000 acres and personal property associated therewith (collectively the "Property") by the South Florida Water Management District ("SFWMD") from United States Sugar Corporation ("USSC").

As a part of negotiating and finalizing the acquisition and valuation of the Property in connection with the captioned transaction, it is necessary for SFWMD to review certain information regarding the Property, including without limitation, leases, reports, grower agreements, independent contractor agreements, financial information, and other contracts and documents (collectively, the "Records"). Some of the Records regarding the Property include, but are not limited to, appraisal reports, offers and counteroffer documents ("Contract Records") as described in Section 373.139(3)(a), Florida Statutes, and trade secrets ("Trade Secret Records") as defined in Section 812.081, Florida Statutes.

SFWMD is bound by the Florida Constitution and Florida Statutes to comply with the laws that permit the public to review Records that are made and received by the District in connection with the District's public business. SFWMD will maintain, pursuant to section 373.139(3)(a) Florida Statutes, all Contract Records exempt from disclosure under the Public Records Act. SFWMD agrees that the Trade Secret Records will be maintained as provided in Paragraph 1 below, provided, however, that to the extent that SFWMD receives any Trade Secret Records, then it will maintain, pursuant to section 815.045, Florida Statutes, all Trade Secret Records exempt from disclosure under the Public Records Act.

In order to permit review of the Trade Secret Records and Contract Records in the custody of USSC by SFWMD, SFWMD and USSC have agreed to the following process:

1. All Records that are claimed to be Trade Secret Records shall be maintained for review solely in electronic format by USSC's counsel, Gunster, Yoakley & Stewart, PA, 777 So. Flagler Drive, Suite 500, East Tower, West Palm Beach, Florida 33401-6194 and shall be separately identified by USSC in a log entitled "Trade Secret Records Log" (the "TSL"). The TSL shall contain the following information:
 - a. The type of record (e.g. grower agreement, milling agreement, etc.)
 - b. For agreements and contracts, the nature of the agreement, the name of the parties and the date.
 - c. The basis of the claim that the record is a trade secret, as defined in section 812.081, Florida Statutes.
 - d. The Records shall be labeled trade secret by USSC.

SFWMD shall be provided a duplicate of the log. SFWMD counsel may review a Trade Secret Record for compliance with the trade secret definition in section 812.081, Florida Statutes. However, a Trade Secret Record shall continue to be considered and maintained as a Trade Secret Record by the SFWMD until such time as otherwise judicially determined.

2. Any records made available by USSC to SFWMD for review that are claimed to be Contract Records shall also be identified by USSC in a log entitled Contract Records Log. The Contract Records Log shall prepared in the same manner and include similar information to the TSL.
3. SFWMD agrees the neither SFWMD nor its contractors, counsel, outside counsel and any other representatives shall disclose any confidential or trade secret information learned from the review of the Records, including the Contract Records or the Trade Secret Records. To the extent that any Trade Secret Records or the contents thereof are attached or incorporated into any reports, appraisals, memoranda or other documentation, then such Trade Secret Records or the information contained therein shall be redacted/omitted therefrom before being released to the public pursuant to the provisions of this letter.

To the extent provided by law, including but not limited to sections 373.139(3)(a) and 815.045, Florida Statutes, SFWMD, its representatives, counsel, outside counsel and contractors shall maintain any Trade Secret Records and Contract Records confidential and exempt from disclosure under the Public Records Act in Chapter 119, Florida Statutes. SFWMD agrees to maintain any Trade Secret Records in its possession confidential and exempt from disclosure during the Records Retention period, as established by the GS1-SL schedule adopted by the State of Florida, Department of State. Once the Records Retention Period has passed, the SFWMD will return them to USSC or dispose of them in accordance with its Records Retention requirements.

With respect to Records which are in SFWMD's possession, SFWMD agrees to provide notice to USSC promptly in the event a third party requests to inspect or copy such Records, including Contract Records or Trade Secret Records. Upon receipt of such notice, USSC shall promptly request in writing that the SFWMD withhold the release of such Records or notify the SFWMD that it has no objection to releasing the Records. If

a third party contests the confidentiality of these Records, it will be USSC's responsibility, at its expense and using counsel of its choice, including any award of attorney fees, to demonstrate to a court of law that the Records or portions thereof are entitled to the maintenance of continued confidentiality in accordance with Florida law. In the event of legal action, SFWMD agrees to cooperate fully in order to insure that the rights of USSC and the requester of the Records are determined promptly.

SFWMD acknowledges the confidential and trade secret nature of the information that it will receive from the Trade Secret Records, and agrees to direct its staff, counsel, outside counsel, representatives and contractors not to disseminate or discuss, other than with the parties to the negotiation, any information obtained from the Trade Secret Records without the prior written consent of USSC.


